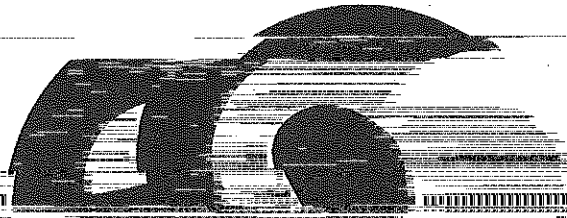

C. Campaign Regulations

1. All campaign literature, leaflets, and other materials and activities must clearly

responsible for the contents and distribution of the campaign material.

2. Campaigning is prohibited in the ASI Business Office and University from

In the event of a tie, all candidates receiving the same number of votes shall be part of a runoff election which will be scheduled immediately by the Elections Committee and held for strictly two (2) days.
