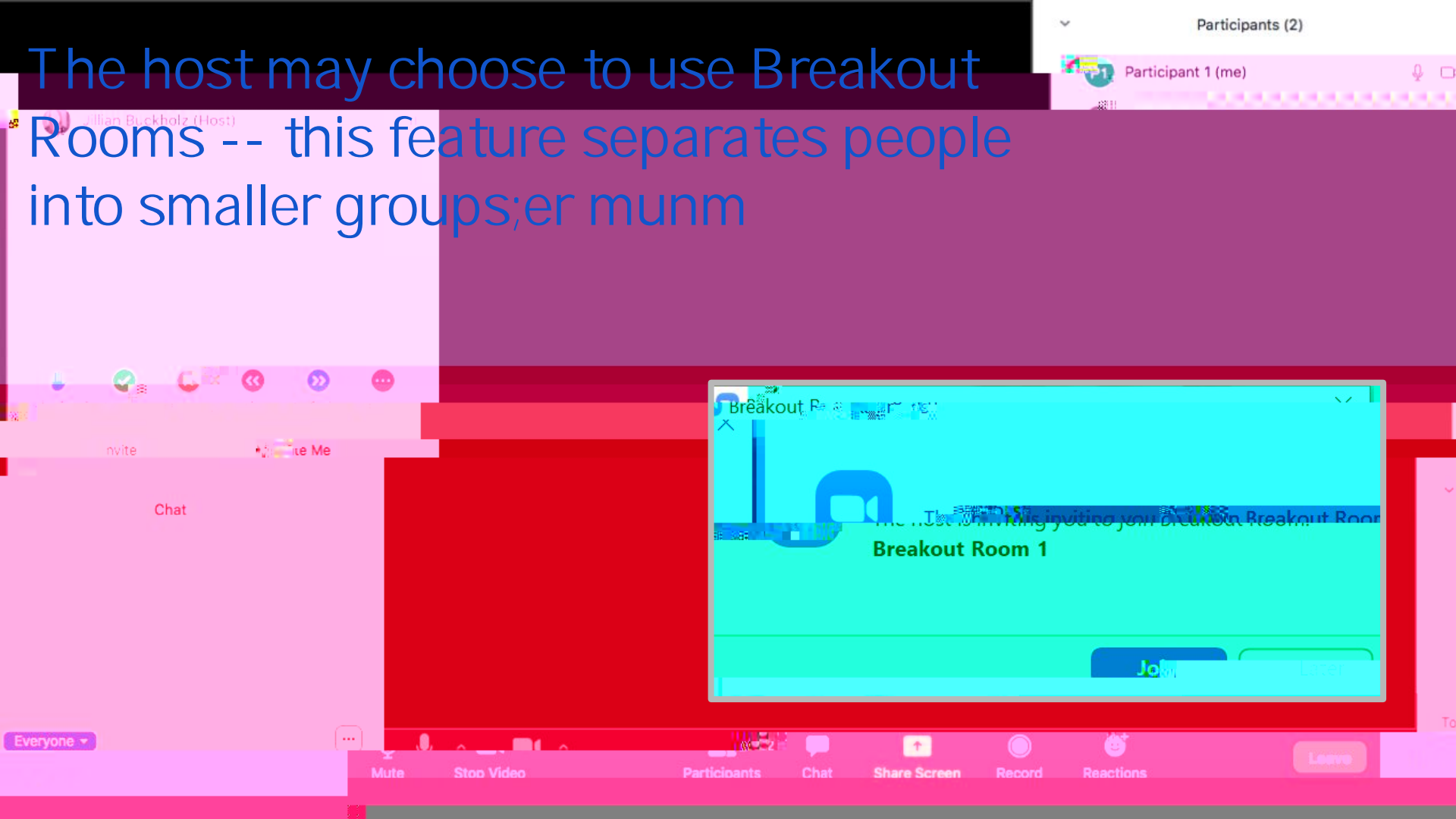

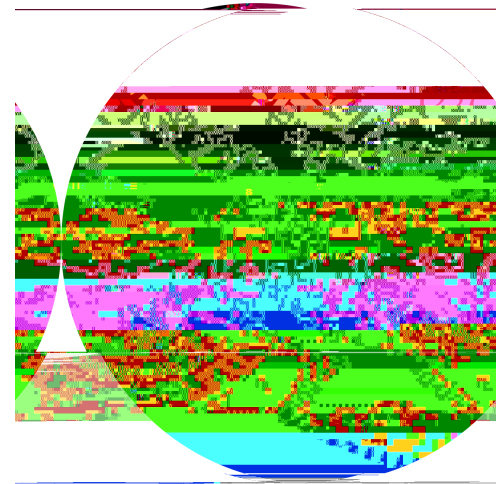
Background

Cal State East Bay Campus Sustainability Committee (CSC) was created in Spring 2015 in order to fulfill:

the California State University System (CSU) Sustainability Policy;
the campus' Shared Strategic Commitment to, “contribute to a sustainable planet through our academic programs, university operations, and individual behavior,”
its sustainability Institutional Learning Outcome to “act responsibly and sustainably at local, national, and global levels,”
and in response to the signing of the Carbon Commitment by President Morishita, which includes a requirement to establish an institutional structure to oversee the development and implementation of the associated requirements.

Purpose

Through transparent decision-making and open discussion forums, the CSC will make recommendations to the Office of the President for how to best meet the directives of the CSU sustainability policy, campus' Carbon Commitment and Climate Action Plan, and overall campus issues related to environmental, economic, and social sustainability.
